Ning Yuan Yu (Mr. Yu)

will be leading these programs. Mr. Yu is an award winning scholar and teaching artist. He has taught Chinese language and culture for over 16 years. While in China, he studied Chinese Literature and Writing in Beijing Luxun Literature College and Sociology in Beijing University. He received his M.S. Ed in Waldorf Education from Sunbridge College in Spring Valley, NY.

Mr. Yu has published 6 books and 2 CDs. "Chinese Children's Folk Songs" received the "Excellent Book Award" from the Chinese Government, Department of Education. This book is used as a textbook and teaching material in both China and America.

Mr. Yu received the Permanent Resident Card (Green Card) for his "Extraordinary Ability" in September 2005. He received the School Arts Partnership Grant award by the New York State Council on the Arts and administered through Partners for Arts Education in 2006 and 2007.

Ning Yuan Yu is now teaching at George School in PA and The Brooklyn Waldorf School in NY. His Chinese curricula and textbooks are published in China.

Terms and Conditions:

I understand and agree:

1. that this payment is for the Spring 2010 term and that I shall not be entitled to any deduction for my child's absences or illnesses during the term; that in the event of my child's withdrawal or suspension from the Mandarin Chinese Program after classes have started, I shall not be entitled to any refund of unused tuition;
2. that the program requires my child to meet certain standards of behavior and that if my child fails to behave or demonstrates repeated unsatisfactory conduct, the Program has the right to dismiss my child from the program;
3. that if my child or I is injured and requires medical attention, I do hereby give authority to The Brooklyn Waldorf School to obtain necessary emergency medical treatment for me or my child with the understanding that the emergency contact listed on the form will be notified as soon as possible;
