

A MESSAGE FROM THE DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

To the parents, students, faculty and Board of Trustees: welcome to the 2017/18 school year! This marks our wonderful school's 13th year in operation. It's exciting to see all of the familiar faces returning to our community, and to welcome so many new arrivals into the fold. We wish you and your families a year of prosperity, health and fulfillment.

The Development Committee is made up of parents, faculty and administrators from the school. We serve on the committee out of love for our unique school, and to support its dedicated community. Our main focus is on fundraising through the Annual Fund, but we also play a role in promoting various events here such as the Winter Fair and the May Fair & Scootathon.

The Development Committee is inspired by the extraordinary culture of giving which permeates the entire Brooklyn Waldorf School community. We will continue to nurture this vital aspect of our still-young school's growth and financial strength; to that end, we'd like to share with you a recap of our efforts from the previous year.

Development activity during the 2016/17 year was robust, underscoring the strength and dedication of our community. Our major fundraising events, Winter Fair in December and Scootathon in May, both exceeded their financial goals. Grandparents & Special Persons Day, so important for building wider connections and organically extending our community as we share the important work taken up in a Waldorf School, was well and enthusiastically attended.

ANNUAL FUND

Each year, we set an ambitious target goal for the Annual Fund, and last year was no exception. The goal that we set was \$350,000. And while we fell well short of that goal, we were able to bring in \$288,433 through the Annual Fund, for our second highest total to date.

Another goal of ours is always to achieve 100% participation in the Annual Fund across our entire community, from parents to faculty & staff to the Board of Trustees; this year, we are exceptionally proud to say that we did just that.

Several times over the year, various families felt compelled to make larger donations, which we were able to offer as matching funds for various challenges (including our first ever #GivingTuesday push and the year-end Participation Challenge, both of which were quite successful). We give our hearty thanks to everyone who gave any amount, but would especially like to recognize these larger donors, without whom our successes would be greatly diminished.

WINTER FAIR


Our annual Winter Fair continued its legacy as a magical experience for all. It really shows off our school operating at its full resplendent strength and beauty, and it is a cornerstone of our annual fundraising efforts. This year, the Winter Fair netted a remarkable \$57,874 for the school - more than \$15,000 higher than in 2015/16, which had previously been our highest-performing Winter Fair to date. This was thanks in no small part to the expertly-run and successful silent auction, and also to some clever new classroom attractions which made their debut there. To everyone who put their talent, creativity and hard work into making this event such a tremendous success: we cannot thank you enough. We look forward to building on last year's success at this year's Winter Fair, which is to take place on Saturday, December 2.

MAY FAIR & SCOOTATHON

Our entire community gathered once again in Prospect Park in early May for this lovely tradition, in which we celebrate the arrival of spring through the May Fair and its Maypole dance, and we raise money for the school through the Scootathon. And as with Winter Fair, the Scootathon had a record-breaking year, raising \$78,770 for the school - surpassing our previous year's donations by more than \$20,000. Thank you to all who helped to organize the event, and to those who volunteered at it. This coming year's May Fair & Scootathon will take place on Cinco de Mayo: Saturday, May 5.
